KINDERGARTEN PAYMENT STRUCTURE:

We use the Abeka live streaming internet Kindergarten program. It is a program that was videoed in at Abeka Academy. There is a teacher in the class that will monitor and work with each student daily. For more info on Abeka Kindergarten please visit their website at www.abekaacademy.org. There is a \$200.00 one time book and live streaming charge.

If you have another child enrolling into another grade you will be discounted \$10 per week.

Tuition payments: Are due by the first Tuesday of each month. Payments that are made by checks are accepted only with pre-approval. A \$25.00 charge will be assessed for each returned check to HBCA. More than one bad check will result in mandatory bank draft. That will cost an additional \$30 per month.

Late Payments: Accounts with past due balances will be charged a late payment fee of \$15 (per child) each Tuesday evening at 6:00 pm. Failure to submit payments to the school administrator for one week will result in termination of enrollment.

Admissions: If you would like to pursue enrollment at Holden Beach Christian Academy, complete an application and return it to the school office by mail or in person Monday through Friday between 9:00am and 3:30pm. The enrollment process at Holden Beach Christian Academy includes a personal interview, testing, submission of required documents, and payment of applicable fees.

SCHOOL YEAR

Our school year begins on the first day after Labor Day and ends Friday of Memorial Day week. We have vacation time during the week of Thanksgiving, Easter, and the weeks over Christmas and New Years. We also schedule various field trips throughout the school year.

CURRICULUM

We use the A.C.E. or Accelerated Christian Education program that is produced by the *School of Tomorrow*, headquartered in Nashville, TN. The *School of Tomorrow* has been used for over 40 years by thousands of churches and parents from all over the world. It is an accredited curriculum that is recognized by colleges and universities all over the country.

The A.C.E. curriculum from School of Tomorrow is based on 5 basic laws of learning:

1. A child must be at a level where he can perform.
2. They must have reasonable goals.
3. Their learning must be controlled, and they must be motivated.
4. Their learning must be measurable.
5. Their learning must be rewarded.

Based on these principles, the A.C.E. curriculum assures parents of:

- A solid, mastery-based, back-to-basics education for your child.
- A course of study diagnostically individualized to meet a student's specific learning needs and capabilities.
- A program incorporating Scripture, Godly character building, and wisdom principles.
